Golden Eagle Survey 2022 Final Report

On January 15, 2022, 195 citizen scientist volunteers from the National Eagle Center spread out across the blufflands and forested areas of southeast Minnesota, western Wisconsin, eastern Iowa, and northwestern Illinois for the 18th annual Wintering Golden Eagle Survey. They were seeking Golden Eagles that winter in the region. The Center greatly appreciates all the time and energy these citizen scientists dedicated to this survey. Although the number of Golden Eagles were a little below average, the numbers for Bald Eagles (1,643) was the second highest count in survey history! Red-tailed Hawk (866) and Rough-legged Hawks (199) also recorded their highest totals to date. This report contains the full survey results.
